IMPORTS

In July of 2014, Belize's total imports were valued at \$184.9 million. This was up 7.5 percent or 12.9 million from the \$172.1 million worth of goods imported in July of 2013 and was primarily due to higher purchases of 'Machinery and Transport Equipment', 'Other Manufactured Goods' and 'Mineral Fuels and Lubricants'.

Imports of diesel rose by \$4.6 million in comparison with last July while those of four cylinder passenger vehicles grew by \$2.5 million. A \$2 million increase in goods destined for the export processing zones was offset by a drop of the same amount in commercial free zone imports. Decreased purchases of fertilizers were reflected in a \$2 million fall in imports of 'Chemical Products'.

Purchases from four of our five major sources of imported goods were up during the month. Their relative share of the total, however, remained virtually unchanged. A quarter of all imports originated in the US while our second largest supplier was Curacao, from which Belize imports its fuels under the Petro Caribe Agreement. The People's Republic of China, Guatemala and Mexico rounded out the top five suppliers.

During the first seven months of this year Belize imported goods totalling \$1.1 billion, 6.4 percent or \$68.4 million more than the same period of 2013. Intermediate goods accounted for one-third of all imports, with the most significant expenditure being on building cement and steel rods.

Figure 1: Monthly Gross Imports and Domestic Exports; January 2010 - July 2014

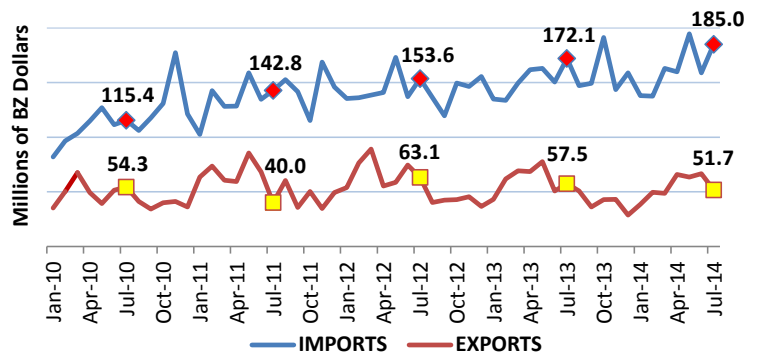
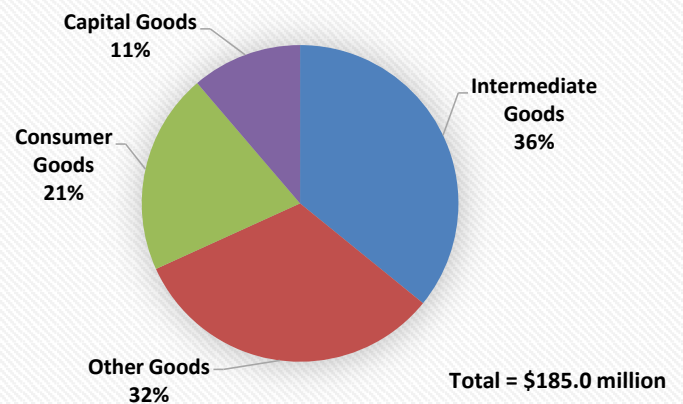


Figure 2: Gross Imports by Type; July 2014



DOMESTIC EXPORTS

Domestic export earnings for July 2014 totalled \$51.7 million, a decline of 13 percent or \$8 million from \$59.7 million in last July. Earnings from four of the country's five major exports declined during the period, with only orange concentrate sales showing a sizeable increase of \$10 million. The most significant drop was recorded for sugar, which plummeted almost 80 percent from \$14 million to \$3 million. Exports of bananas and marine products were down by \$2.5 million and \$2 million, respectively, while crude oil earnings declined marginally.

Over a half of all Belize's merchandise exports for the month were destined for the US, while the United Kingdom and the European Union accounted for 28 percent. Almost 9 percent of total exports went to the CARICOM region, where there is a growing market for non-traditional exports such as animal feed and grains.

From January to July of 2014 export receipts declined by \$55.4 million or 12.4 percent to \$390.3 million compared to the same period of 2013. All major exports were down for this period except for marine products, earnings from which were boosted by the resurgence of the shrimp industry.

Figure 3: Merchandise Trade with Selected Countries/Regions; July 2014

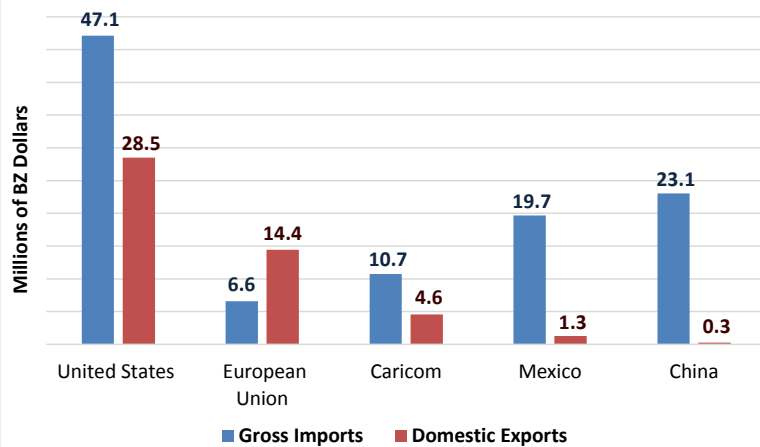
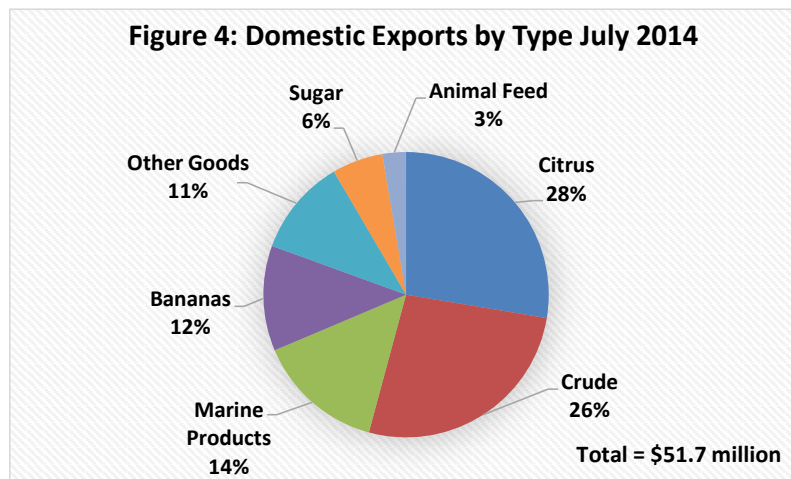


Figure 4: Domestic Exports by Type July 2014
