#### IMPORTS

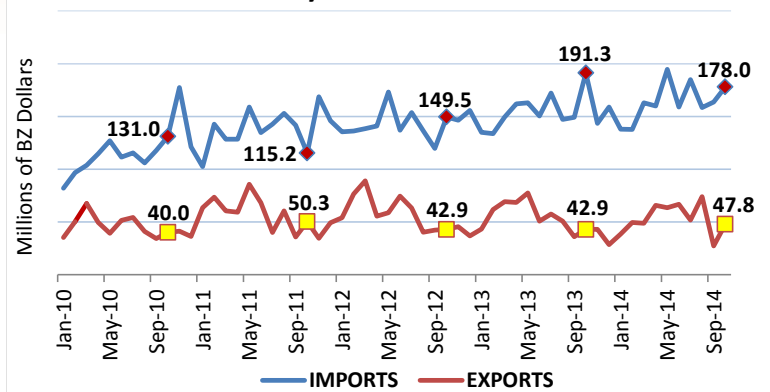
For the month of October 2014, the total value of merchandise imports was \$178 million, according to the Statistical Institute of Belize's most recent external trade statistics. This was down by 7 percent or \$13.3 million from the \$191.3 million imported during same month last year.

'Mineral Fuels and Lubricants' fell by \$7.3 million from \$28 to \$21 million, owing to a sharp decline in purchases of diesel fuel for the month compared to last October. A \$3.5 million drop in imports of durum wheat during the month led to a 21 percent reduction in the category of 'Food and Live Animals'. 'Manufactured Goods' fell by \$3.3 million to \$20 million, as a result of decreased purchases of metal bars and rods for construction. Imports of 'Other Manufactures' dropped by almost a half to \$14.5 million, due entirely to a \$12 million fall in purchases of gold jewellery and wristwatches, which had temporarily spiked during October 2013.

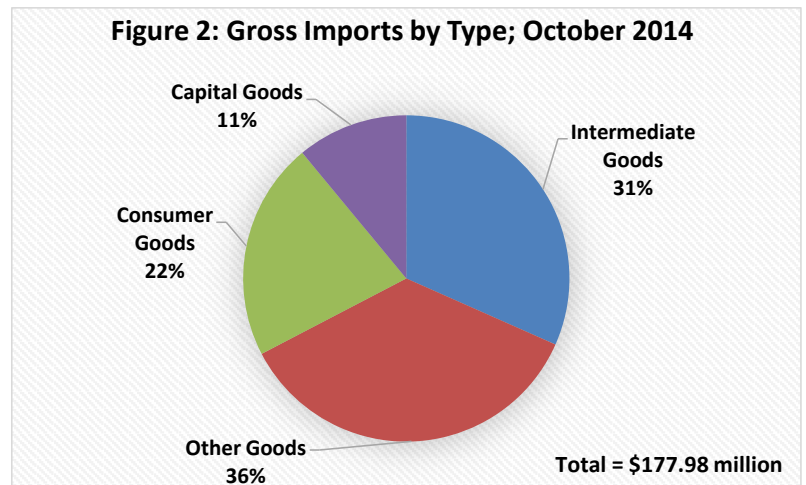
With almost 30 percent of imports originating in the United States, this country remains the major source of goods coming into the country. However, with the fall in fuel imports during the month, China overtook Curaçao as Belize's second largest import source.

Notwithstanding the decrease in imports for the month, total goods coming into the country during the first ten months of the year rose by over \$80 million to \$1.6 billion compared to the same period in 2013, with notable increases in purchases of motor vehicles for the transportation of goods, personal transport vehicles, and diesel fuel.

**Figure 2: Gross Imports by Type; October 2014**

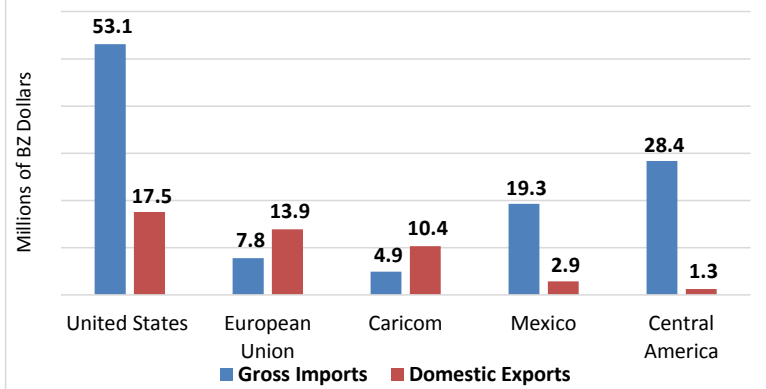


### DOMESTIC EXPORTS

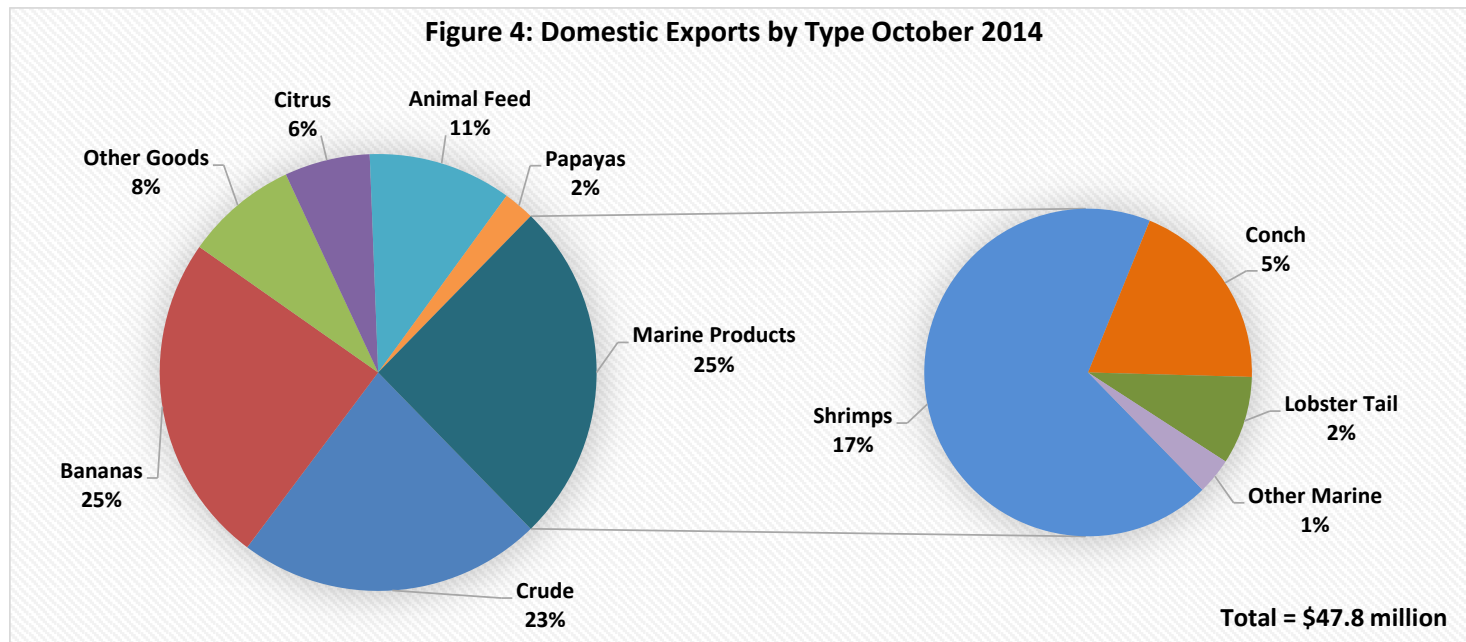
The total value of Belize's domestic exports for the month was \$47.8 million, up \$2.5 million or 5.5 percent from \$45.3 million last October. This was due largely to improved sales of bananas, which rose by almost \$3 million from \$8.7 million to \$11.6 million, and a \$3.7 million jump in sales of animal feed. These, along with smaller increases in exports of orange concentrate, sugar and beans, were sufficient to offset reductions in crude petroleum and marine products, which fell by \$2.5 million and \$3.4 million, respectively during the month.

For the year to date the total value of goods exported dropped \$41.2 million or 7.1 percent from \$583.8 million to \$542.6 million. Of this decline, \$40 million was attributed to a fall in exports of crude petroleum, from \$127.5 million during the first ten months of last year to \$87.8 million during the same period this year. Citrus concentrate and papaya sales were also down, by \$9.7 million and \$7.1 million, respectively. Marine products, on the other hand, continued to perform strongly, with exports rising by \$11.6 million or 13.8 percent during the period.
