IMPORTS

Belize imported a total of \$183.3 million worth of goods during the month of November 2014, according to figures released by the Statistical Institute of Belize. This represented an increase of almost \$40 million or 27.7 percent when compared to the \$143.5 million imported during last November, with imports up across all categories of goods for the month.

Purchases of 'Food and Live Animals' rose by \$7.4 million to \$23.7 million, with about half of this increase being attributed to higher durum wheat imports. 'Mineral Fuels and Lubricants' purchased also totalled \$23.7 million, up from \$18.9 million last November, due almost entirely to increased purchases of diesel. Imports of 'Machinery and Transport Equipment' grew by over \$4 million from \$29.6 million to \$33.8 million. Goods destined for Commercial Free Zones rose by almost \$11 million while those going to Export Processing Zones almost doubled from \$6.4 million to \$12.2 million.

For the first eleven months of 2014 total merchandise imports rose by more than \$120 million or 7.1 percent, from \$1.7 billion to \$1.8 billion. Higher imports were recorded across most categories of goods, with major increases being recorded in the purchases of motor vehicles for the transportation of goods, four-cylinder vehicles for personal transport, diesel, and goods going to Export Processing Zones.

Figure 1: Monthly Gross Imports and Domestic Exports; January 2010 - November 2014

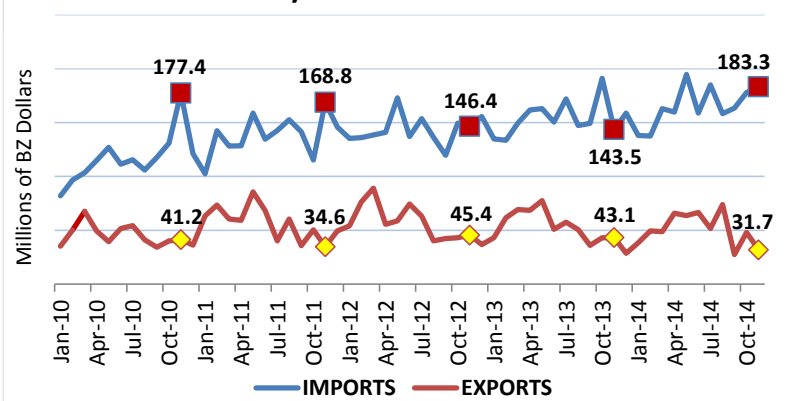
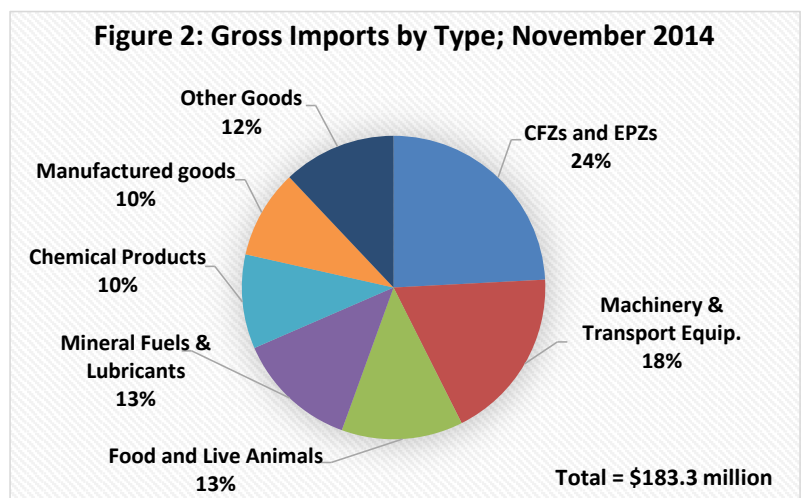


Figure 2: Gross Imports by Type; November 2014



DOMESTIC EXPORTS

Total domestic exports for the month fell by \$13.7 million or 30.2 percent from \$45.5 million to \$31.7 million. Sales of marine products dropped by \$6 million, reflecting decreases in exports of both shrimp and conch, while crude petroleum exports fell by almost \$5 million from \$12.7 million to \$7.8 million. Orange concentrate was down by \$3.7 million, from \$5.7 million last November to only \$1.9 million this month. Sales of the other two major exports, bananas and sugar, rose by \$1.1 million and \$0.7 million, respectively, for the month.

Goods exported during the period from January to November 2014 were valued at \$574.3 million. This was almost \$55 million lower than in the same period last year, when total exports were \$629.2 million. Of the country's major exports, crude petroleum continued to record the greatest losses, with sales of this product down by over \$44 million from \$140.2 million to \$95.6 million. Citrus concentrate exports declined by \$14 million over the eleven months from \$102.4 million to \$88.4 million. The farm shrimp industry continued to boost sales of marine products, which grew by \$5.5 million, while bananas and sugar rose by \$2.8 million each, compared to the same period in 2013.

Figure 3: Merchandise Trade with Selected Countries/Regions; November 2014

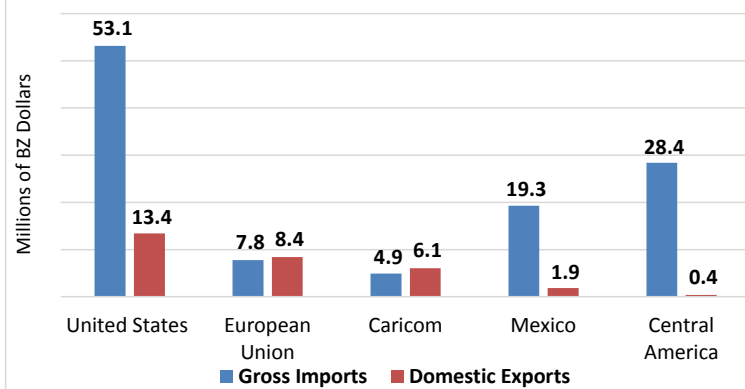
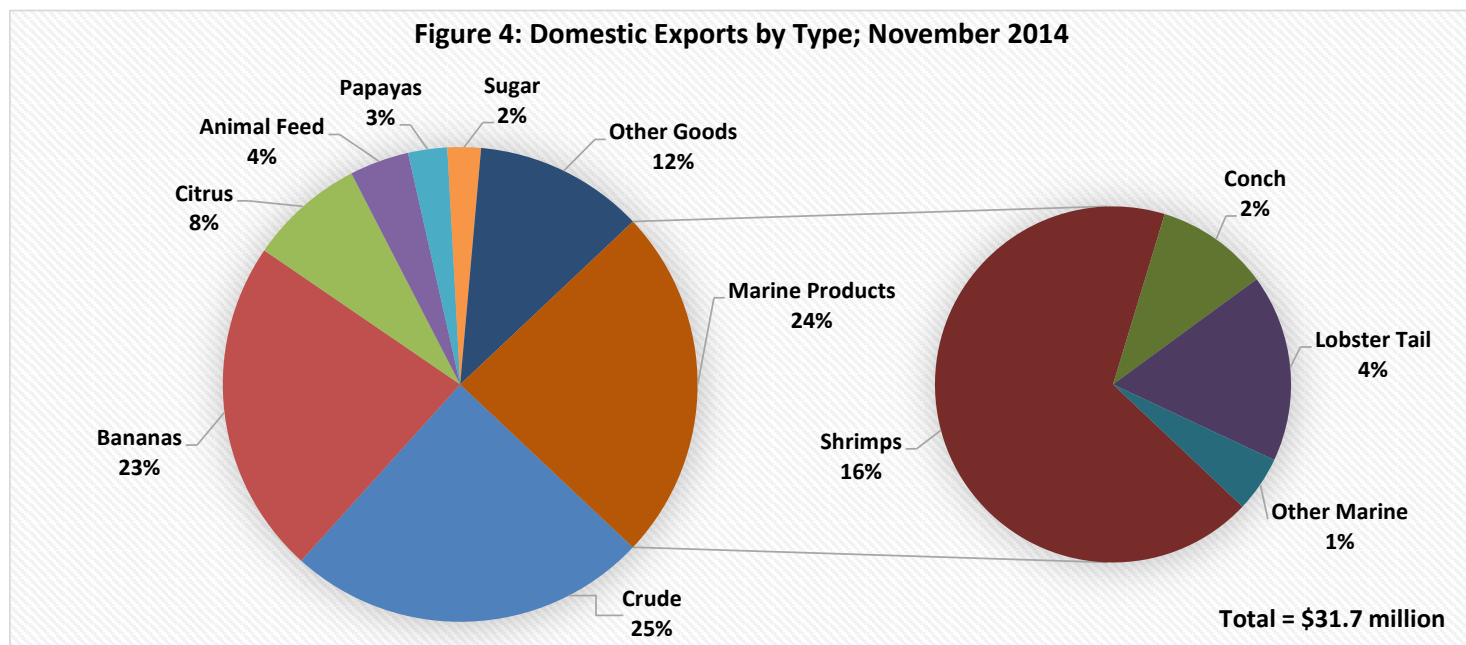


Figure 4: Domestic Exports by Type; November 2014
