

IMPORTS UP 20% WHILE EXPORTS FALL BY 21% IN JUNE 2015

IMPORTS

During the month of June 2015, Belize imported goods valued at \$189.2 million, up by \$31.7 million or 20.1 percent from the \$157.5 million imported in June of 2014.

'Machinery and Transport Equipment' had the largest increase of almost \$16 million, from \$31 million to \$47 million, due to purchases of sailboats and airplanes during the month. 'Manufactured Goods' grew by more than \$6 million, to almost \$24 million, the result of growth in the imports of various construction supplies. Additionally, a spike in wheat seed purchases led to a \$5 million increase in imports of 'Food and Live Animals'. In contrast, 'Mineral Fuels and Lubricants' fell from \$17 million to \$14 million, owing both to a decrease in the quantity of fuel imported as well as to lower fuel prices on the world market, compared to last June.

Goods destined for the Commercial Free Zone grew by almost \$4 million, as importation of cigarettes and clothing continued their upward trend. Imports into the Export Processing Zones, on the other hand, recorded a decrease of over \$1 million, reflecting a fall in shrimp feed purchases.

Merchandise imports for the first half of 2015 totaled almost \$1 billion, representing an increase of 5 percent or \$46 million over the same period last year. Notable growths were observed in the categories of 'Machinery and Transport Equipment' and 'Manufactured Goods', resulting from heightened purchases of transportation equipment, bottling equipment, and construction supplies. Additionally, imports to the Commercial Free Zones grew by \$21 million over the period. A significant \$35 million less was spent on 'Mineral Fuels and Lubricants', despite an increase in the quantity of all fuels purchased, reflecting lower world market prices.

EXPORTS

The total value of Belize's domestic exports for the month of June 2015 was \$52.6 million, down \$14 million or 21 percent from the \$66.6 million recorded in June 2014. This decline was due primarily to decreased exports of some of the country's top export earners, including orange concentrate and shrimp.

Citrus exports fell by a substantial \$14 million, due almost entirely to a steep drop in orange concentrate sales, from more than \$15 million to just under \$3 million. However, this was due to a delayed crop and a change in reaping practices. A surge in orange concentrate sales is expected in the coming months.

Marine exports dropped by \$4 million, as shrimp earnings were halved in the month of June, from \$7.4 million to \$3.6 million. This signaled the first effects of the Early Mortality Syndrome (EMS) disease, which has begun to affect the farm shrimp industry. Sugar, the only major export to have increased during the month, grew by \$6 million, from \$19 million to \$25 million. A major part of this increase was attributed to a large shipment for the month, which also included May's bulk sugar shipment. Banana exports remained virtually unchanged at just over \$9 million.

Merchandise exports to United States of America rose by more than \$12 million, as \$21 million worth of Belize's sugar sales were to that country. Concurrently, exports to the United Kingdom diminished by over \$14 million, due primarily to a drop in sugar sales to this nation and reflecting the growing US market for this product. Exports to Mexico were adversely affected by reduced sales of farm shrimp while diminished orange concentrate sales resulted in a drop in exports to the European Union.

Goods exported for the first six months of 2015, totaled \$304 million, \$37 million less than the \$341 million exported during the same period in 2014. Crude petroleum contributed greatly to that decline, with earnings dropping sharply by almost \$33 million from \$51 million to \$18 million during the period.

Figure 1: Monthly Gross Imports and Domestic Exports; June 2010 - June 2015

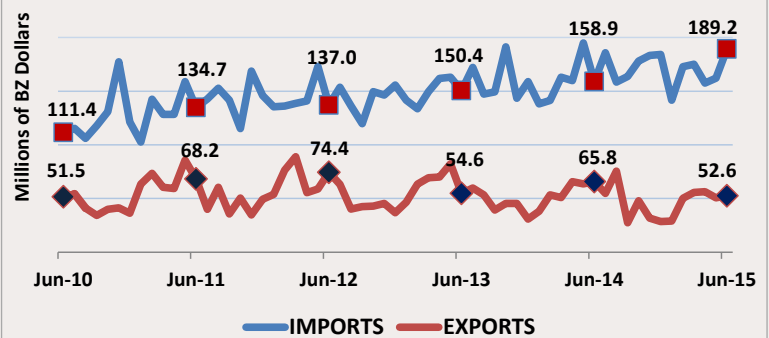


Figure 2: Composition of Gross Imports by Type; June 2015



Figure 3: Domestic Exports to Selected Countries/Regions; June 2015 and June 2014

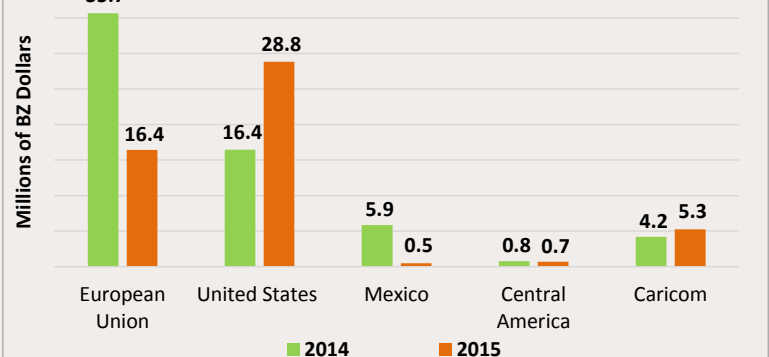
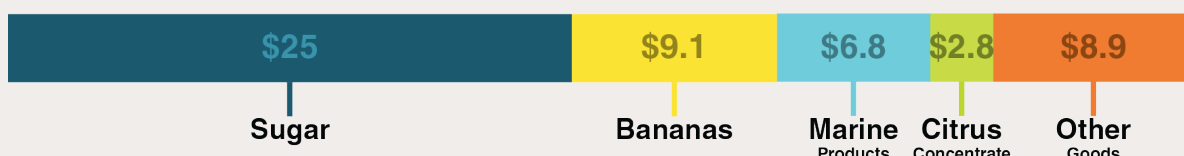


Figure 4: Composition of Exports by Type; June 2015 (Millions of BZ Dollars)
