# Introduction

Your role as a Data Coder in Belize's 2010 Population and Housing Census is critical in the successful dissemination of accurate and timely data.

Your job is to convert answers to specific responses given by the interviewee in to numeric codes. These codes enable us to analyze and report more easily and precisely on the data we have collected.

Before the questionnaire reaches you, it will have passed through the hands of the enumerator in the field who will have spent considerable time and effort collecting the responses from the interviewee. It will then have been checked by a Field Supervisor, a Zone Supervisor and a District or Assistant District Supervisor, and perhaps an Editor.

Your's is the final act before the questionnaire is scanned in to a database and analyzed. It is very important that after all the hard work which has gone in to collecting and editing this data, that you diligently perform your job.

Your's in a highly specialized job, and this workshop is specifically designed to give you the knowledge and information necessary for you to perform well as a Data Coder. You should be aware of the other people in your office, and in neighbouring offices, as these people will be a good source of support, and you should foster an environment of knowledge sharing and problem solving.

# How to Record Codes in the Questionnaire

To record the code in the questionnaire you will write clearly and legibly in 2B pencil only, the numbers in the grey boxes. These grey boxes indicate that they are to be completed by you the coder (in section 9 of the Person questionnaire, the enumerator may also fill in the code if it is one of the five countries listed). In addition to writing the numbers, for certain questions you will also be required to shade in bubbles which relate to those numbers. In the example below, the code being entered is 123. Because there are four boxes for the code, and only 3 numbers to enter, you leave the first box empty. You then write the numbers clearly in the other boxes, and shade the appropriate bubbles in the row.

## **Questions to be Coded**

The following is the list of the questions that you will code, based on the written answer provided by the interviewee and transcribed by the enumerator:

#### Cover Page: CTV

Based on the address details given on Page 2 of the questionnaire you will record the city, town or village code on the cover page of the questionnaire. These codes are found on pages 28 to 29.

#### Page 7: Section 2 - Emigration

This section has 2 questions that require coding, questions 2.5 and 2.7. The first is the occupation of the person who emigrated, and the second is the country that the person emigrated to. These codes are found on pages 21 to 21, and 30 to 37 respectively. In this section you will only write in the numeric code in the appropriate boxes, since there are no bubbles to shade. The section may contain information on up to five people.

#### Page 11: Section 9 - Migration

There are up to five questions in section 9, which need coding. In questions 9.1a, 9.1b and 9.4 you code the country that is written in using the codes found on pages 30 to 37. For questions 9.2 and 9.7, it is the CTV that you will code using the tables found on pages 28 to 29. For all five questions you will write the code ion the boxes and shade the appropriate bubbles.

#### Page 13: Section 11 – Education

There is only 1 question that requires you to code the answer in to a numeric value, and that is question 11.3. Again you will write the code in the boxes provided and shade the appropriate bubbles.

#### Page 13: Section 13 - Training

There is only a single question in this section which needs coding, question 13.3. This uses the same coding frame as question 11.3 in the Education section (see above).

#### Page 14: Section 14 – Economic Activity

There are three different questions in this section, each using a different coding frame. Question 14.7b records the person's main duties performed in their main job, and you will write the numeric code in the boxes, and shade the appropriate bubbles in the correct rows. The occupation codes that you will use can be found on pages 21 to 21. Question 14.8b records the main economic activity of the establishment where the person is employed. You will again convert the written description in to a numeric code which will be written in the boxes, and shade the appropriate bubbles. These codes are found on pages 4 through 4. The final question in this section that requires your attention is 14.8c, which records the CTV of the establishment. The CTV codes are found on pages 28 to 29.

# Economic Activity Codes: ISIC and BCEA

The following table lists the description of many economic activities, and the corresponding two numeric codes that we use to analyze this data. The code on the left, in the first column, is the International Standard Industrial Classification of All Economic Activities (ISIC) version 4, which is a United Nations system of classification. The column on the right lists the BCEA code, which is the Belize Classification of Economic Activity, which as the name suggests is specific to Belize.
