

GROSS DOMESTIC PRODUCT

WHAT?

The **Gross Domestic Product** or **GDP** is the total monetary value of all final goods and services produced within Belize in a year.

WHY?

GDP is the main indicator of economic activity and economic growth. It informs and guides policy-makers in making decisions for the country. It is also used by many international organizations, NGOs, researchers, teachers, students, and the media.

HOW?

GDP estimates are based on production and financial data from government, private businesses and non-government organizations.

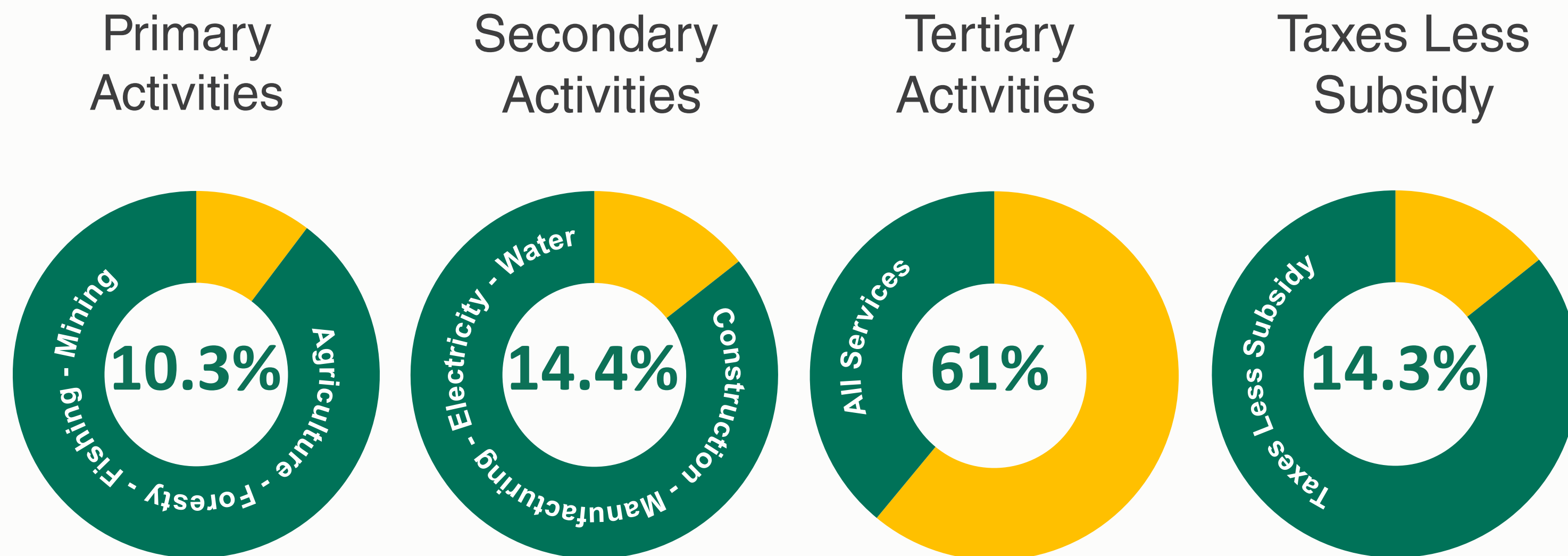
WHEN?

GDP is compiled on a quarterly and an annual basis. The quarterly estimates are at constant market prices to get quick information on the growth of the economy. The annual estimates are produced both in current and constant market prices.

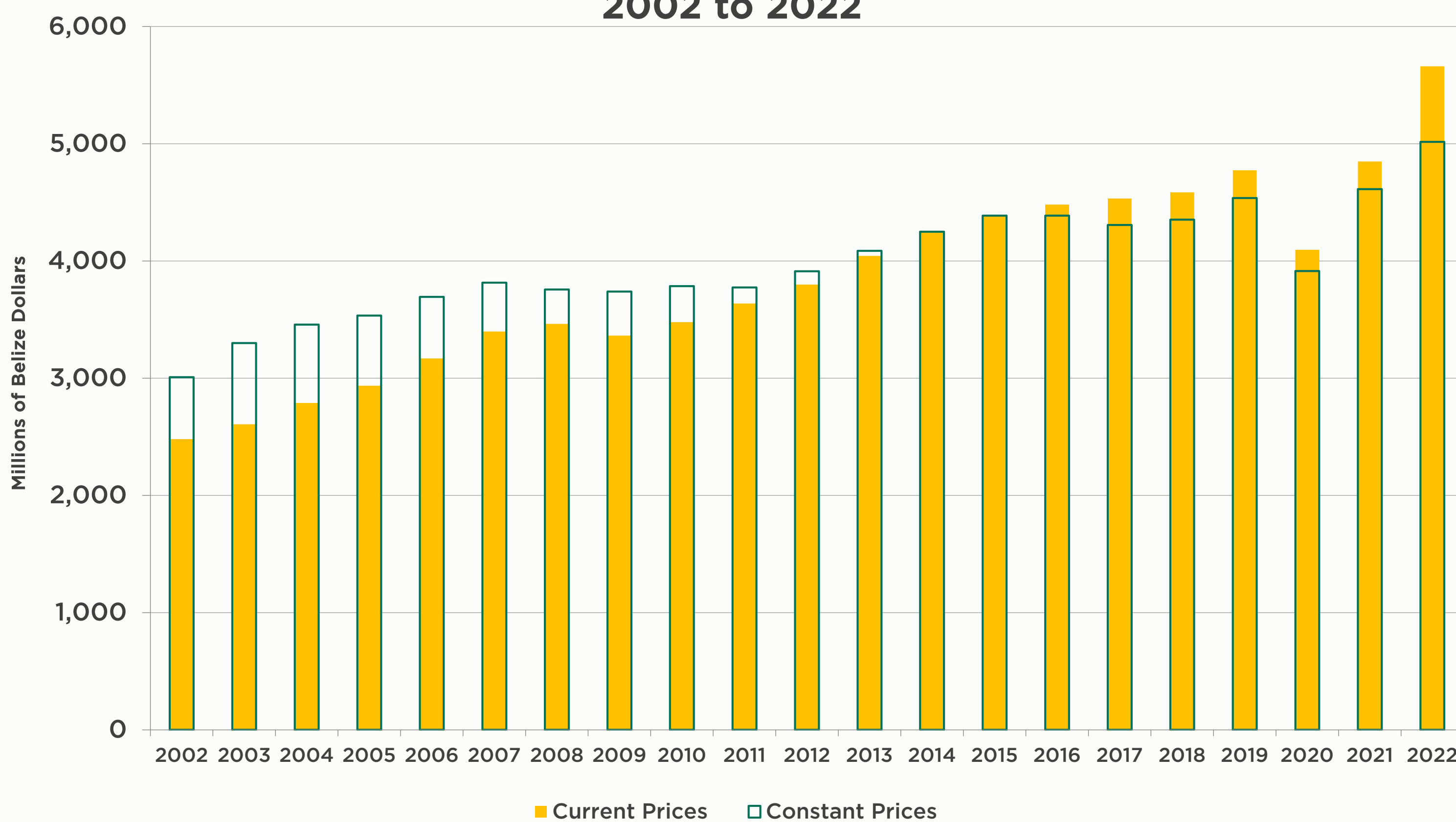
WHO?

The **Statistical Institute of Belize (SIB)** is the agency that produces official **GDP** estimates for Belize.
