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INTRODUCTION

The Statistical Institute of Belize (SIB) conducts two labour force surveys each year; one in April during the high season of employment, and the other in September; the low season. This report highlights the results of the April 2013 survey and compares them to the results of the April 2012 survey.



PRELIMINARY FINDINGS

I. Unemployment Rate


1. Country

In April 2013, the national unemployment rate was estimated to be 11.7 percent, a decrease from 14.4 percent in April 2012. The unemployment rate represents the number of persons of working age in the labour force that are not working but are available for work compared to those who have jobs. At the district level, Stann Creek recorded the highest unemployment rate (15.0%) while Toledo had the lowest at 8.0 percent. When compared to April 2012, the unemployment rate decreased in all districts. Cayo and Toledo had the sharpest fall in their unemployment rates, with decreases of almost 6.0 percentage points each.




2. Area and Sex

In April 2013, the urban and rural unemployment rates were 11.5 percent and 11.8 percent respectively, both decreasing by more than 2.0 percentage points from twelve months earlier. Females experienced an unemployment rate of 20.2 percent, which more than triples the male unemployment rate of 6.1 percent. In previous surveys, the female unemployment rate was usually a little more than twice the male rate.




3. Ethnicity

Among the four major ethnic groups, Creoles again experienced the highest unemployment rate at 16.2 percent. All ethnic groups except for Creoles experienced decreases in their unemployment rate from April 2012. Mayas recorded the lowest unemployment rate at 9.9 percent.



4. Age


Persons between the ages of 14 and 24 years continued to experience the highest rate of unemployment at almost twice the national average. The 55 years to 64 years population recorded the lowest unemployment rate.




5. Place of Birth and Education

As shown in Figure 5, persons born in Belize were more than one and a half times likely to be affected by joblessness than persons born abroad. During the survey month, approximately one in every eight of them in the labour force did not have a job, compared to a rate of one in thirteen for foreign-born persons.

Persons completing primary school had the highest unemployment rate at 14.9 percent. Meanwhile, persons that had completed tertiary schooling had the lowest rate (7.6%).







II. Labour Force

1. Country

In April 2013, at 148,736 the size of the labour force was virtually unchanged from twelve months earlier. However, there was a slight dip in the labour force participation rate from 65.7 percent to 64.6 percent. The Labour Force Participation Rate is the proportion of working age persons who are employed or unemployed compared to those who are not economically active. The Corozal and Belize districts had the highest labour force participation rates and Toledo the lowest rate.




The distribution of the labour force across the districts remains in direct consonance with the spread of the population, with the Belize and Toledo districts accounting for the largest and smallest concentration, respectively.



2. Labour force by District and Sex


Males dominate the labour force in all districts. The Belize District had the smallest difference between the sexes, with males outnumbering females by about 5.0 percent. This contrasted sharply with the Toledo District where men in the labour force outnumbered women by a ratio of almost 3 to 1.




3. Area, Sex and Place of Birth

Labour force participation remained slightly higher in urban areas than rural areas. However, rural areas accounted for a little more than one-half of the labour force due to having a larger population than urban areas.


Reflecting their composition of the total population, persons born in Belize accounted for more than four-fifths of the labour force, with males exceeding females by a ratio of three to two. As in previous surveys, roughly four of every five males of working age were in the labour force, compared to only one-half of their female counterparts.






4. Ethnicity

Among the four major ethnic groups, Figure 12 shows the labour force participation rate varied from 54.4 percent for Mayas to 67.6 percent for Garinagus.



The number of persons in the labour force by ethnicity did not change much from 12 months earlier. The Creoles had the largest increase in the labour force each increasing by over 1.0 percent. Meanwhile, the Mayas had a slight dip of about 1.0 percentage point.



5. Age

Persons between the ages of 25 and 54 years continue to have the highest labour force participation rates (Figure 14). The labour force participation rate fell precipitously at ages 55 and 65, the official retirement age for government workers and the age at which males become entitled for social security pension payments.






Figure 15 illustrates that age groups with larger and smaller percentages of the labour force population had similar labour force participation rates in Figure 14, except for the youth 14 to 24 years, which had one of the higher percentages of persons in the labour force but one of the lowest labour force participation rates.




6. Education


As much as 42.0 percent of the labour force had only completed primary education while 19.4 percent had not completed any formal education similar to April 2012 (39.9 and 21.2 percent, respectively).



7. Place of Birth and Education

Although persons born in Belize made up the majority of the labour force, foreign born persons had a higher labour force participation rate. The Labour force participation rate by highest level of education completed was similar across all levels except for the secondary and tertiary levels, which had the highest labour force participation rates. 




III. Unemployed Labour Force


1. Country and District

According to the results of the April 2013 Labour Force Survey, there were approximately 17,367 unemployed persons in that month, a 19.0 percent decrease from twelve months earlier. These persons were distributed across the six districts in almost direct proportion to the size of each district. When compared to the same month of the previous year, the most significant improvement was in Cayo where the number of unemployed persons decreased by 6.0 percent. Meanwhile, the number of unemployed persons in Belize increased by 6.0 percent.




2. Area, Sex and Place of Birth

The majority of unemployed persons resided in rural areas, with the percentage increasing by 2.0 points from April last year. Even though their labour force participation rate was significantly lower than males, there were more than twice as many unemployed females than males. This represented a 6.0 percent increase from the same period a year earlier.




3. Ethnicity

The distribution of the unemployed population across the major ethnic groups has not changed much from April 2012. The Mestizo and Creole accounted for more than three-fourths of the unemployed population (Figure 21).




4. Age

Similar to April 2012, youth accounted for the highest proportion of the unemployed population, with nearly one-half of the unemployed population. It is evident that older persons are more likely to be employed than younger persons because of having more skills, experience, or education.



5. Education


More than half of the unemployed population had only completed a primary education again accounting for the majority of the population (a 6.8 percent increase from April 2012). The most significant change was with those persons not completing any formal education (decreasing by almost 10.0 percent).



IV. Employed Labour Force


1. Country and District

There were 131,369 persons working in Belize in April 2013, an increase of 4.0 percent from April 2012. However; there was not much difference across the districts compared to the previous 12 months with Belize and Toledo having a minor increase of half a percent.




2. Area, Sex and Place of Birth

The distribution of the employed labour force indicated that rural areas accounted for a slightly higher portion than urban. Conversely, employed males continue to outnumber their female counterparts by a ratio of almost 2 to 1.




3. Ethnicity

Employment remained constant across ethnicity with very little change when compared to April 2012. Only the Creole saw a slight increase in the employed labour force population with a gain of about half of a percent.




4. Age

Persons aged 14 to 44 years account for almost three-fourths of the country's employed labour force. This shows that the country's employed labour force is fairly young, with the 25 to 34 years age group comprising the largest percentage of the employed population. Age seems to affect employment as from age 25 onward employment steadily decreases as the age increases.




5. Education

The employed labour force is fairly educated with more than three fourths of the population having completed at least a primary level of education. A slight increase of 1.7 percent what it was 12 months earlier.




6. Main Occupation

Of all employed persons, a little over one-third of them were engaged in clerical/service or sales related jobs. There was a significant change in the number of persons employed in elementary jobs with a decrease of more than 4.0 percentage points compared to April 2012. Meanwhile the number of persons in skilled agricultural/Craft/Plant & Machinery jobs saw an increase of about 4.0 percent.



7. Industry

The overall distribution of the employed labour force by industry has not changed from the previous 12 months. However, there was a significant increase (4.3%) in the number of persons working in the services sector.




V. Labour Force Definitions

Standard Labour Force definitions and concepts are as follows. Relationships between the definitions are presented in Figure 30.

- Working-age population: All persons 14 years or older
- *Employed Population*: Persons in the working-age population with jobs during the survey reference week.
- Unemployed Population: Persons in the working-age population who do not have a job
 or business during the survey week but was available to work if he was given the
 opportunity to do so during the two weeks before the reference week.
- Not in the Labour Force: Members of the working-age population who are neither employed nor unemployed.
- Labour Force: Those persons who are either employed or unemployed
