What is the Gross Domestic Product (GDP)?

GDP is defined as the total value of all finished goods and services produced within an economy for a given period.

GDP is used as the main indicator of economic activity within a country.

Gross Domestic ProductFirst quarter (January - March 2022)

Goods and services produced totaled \$1.21 billion

An increase of \$61.3 million or 5.3% when compared to the first quarter of 2021.

This represented the **highest level of production for any first quarter on record**, surpassing the pre-pandemic production levels recorded for the first quarter of 2019.

Moreover, revised quarterly estimates indicated that, by the end of 2021, the country's economic output had effectively recovered to levels exceeding those recorded for prepandemic 2019.


Gross domestic product at constant prices First quarter, 2017 - 2022
























Marine exports First quarter, 2017 - 2022








Water consumption










Milk production






