What is the Gross Domestic Product (GDP)?

 GDP is defined as the total value of all finished goods and services produced within an economy for a given period.

 GDP is used as the main indicator of economic activity within a country.

Third quarter (July-September 2023)


Goods and services produced totaled \$1.199 billion

An increase of **\$40.0 million** or **3.4%** when compared to the third quarter of 2022.

Primary drivers of economic growth were in the tertiary sector and 'Construction' from the secondary sector.


First quarter 2018 to third quarter 2023

Contribution share to GDP by sector




















Marine exports Third quarter, 2018 - 2023
















Sugar production Third quarter, 2018 - 2023






