What is the Gross Domestic Product (GDP)?

 GDP is defined as the total value of all finished goods and services produced within an economy for a given period.

 GDP is used as the main indicator of economic activity within a country.


First Quarter

An increase of \$136.2 million or 10% when compared to the First Quarter of 2023.


Primary drivers of economic growth were in the secondary and tertiary sector.

























Marine exportsFirst Quarter, 2019 - 2024






Flour production






