 GDP is defined as the total value of all finished goods and services produced within an economy for a given period.

 GDP is used as the main indicator of economic activity within a country.

# **Gross Domestic Product**Real GDP 2023


Annual

An increase of \$53.5 million or 1.1% when compared to 2022.



GDP 10.5% Goods and services produced totaled \$1.432 billion


An increase of \$135.9 million or 10.5% when compared to the Second Quarter of 2023.

- Primary economic growth drivers were the tertiary sector industries, including Wholesale and retail trade,
   Accommodation and food service activities, and Transport.
- All sectors showed growth, including the primary sector, which had recorded several consecutive quarters of contraction.

### **Driver share to GDP growth rate Second Quarter, 2024**


















**Soft drink production Second Quarter, 2019 - 2024** 




**Beer production Second Quarter, 2019 - 2024** 






Flour production Second Quarter, 2019 - 2024






**Sugar production Second Quarter, 2019 - 2024** 






